# Closing of Molok® lifting bags

Insert the ball-shaped head of the rope guide in to the bottom of the rope lock.

Grab a good hold of the rope guide and rope lock with your other hand.



# Closing of Molok® lifting bags

Hold firmly on the rope lock and rope guide while simultaneously tightening the rope with your other hand.

You can also use the edge of the container to hold the rope lock in place while tightening the rope.



# Closing of Molok® lifting bags

When the rope is tightened keep the tension in the rope and pull the rope as you place the rope inside the teeth of the rope lock.

Lock the rope in place by threading it inside the securing loop by pulling the rope to the right .



# Closing of Molok® lifting bags

Make a bundle of the remaining rope and place it through the loop above the rope lock to avoid the rope dropping to the bottom of the container and keeping it clean.

Before placing the bag back inside the container, check that the bottom of the bag is closed properly. If not, re-open the bag and do the closing procedure again.

Make sure that the rope and rope lock is clean and dry of detergents, oily substances etc. that might cause the rope to slip when the bag is full. Molok is not liable for the bag opening while emptying due to mis-use or the parts being, wet, dirty or otherwise not in operating condition due to lack of cleaning or maintenance of the bag and its parts.
